Class descriptions—please read!

B'n'S Ute: includes BnS utes and BnS style utes. Does not have to have attended a BnS

Feral Ute: Self explanatory but MUST be registered

Country Ute: Decked out for country use or driving

Classic Ute: Any ute build up to and including 1980

Street Ute: for the clean and tidy “daily driver” - NO SHOW OR THEME UTES

Show/Theme Ute: Utes built with a theme or show purposes in mind—NO STREET UTES

Work/Trade Ute: Utes specifically used for work or a trade—proof of trade or signage

Best 4WD: Open to ANY 4WD utility vehicle

Best Chicks: Open to any ute OWNED and REGISTERED by a female (proof required)

Best Holden: Open to any utility build by Holden

Best Ford: Open to any utility built by Ford

UTE MUSTER ENTRY CONDITIONS:

1. While all care will be taken, no responsibility for damage will be taken by the show society or its committee members, conveners or stewards. VEHICLES ENTERED AT OWN RISK
2. Vehicles MUST be registered to be allowed on the grounds—registrations WILL be checked by the conveners and unregistered vehicles will be asked to leave. THIS IS AN INSURANCE REQUIREMENT.
3. Revving of engines (outside of any competition taking place) will not be tolerated and you will be asked to leave
4. The judge(s) have the power to exclude or move vehicles between classes if they feel they do not fit the spirit of the class being judged.
